THE R₂₅/₃H COURSE

- > Start on access road to Hirwaun industrial estate (e293120/n206180, OS sheets 170/160) 8 yards north of lamp column number 1 and 30 yards north of junction with unclassified road (old a465) Hirwaun to Cefn Rhigos. 0.000 miles.
- ➤ Proceed south to junction with unclassified road (on to the old route) and bear left to roundabout with A4061 (Rhigos mountain road) where take second exit (straight on) to Hirwaun roundabout A465 to take first exit. 1.306 miles.
- Continue along A465 to Blaengwrach roundabout (McDonalds) to take second exit (straight on). 7.169 miles.
- Continue on A465 to Resolven roundabout to take third exit (straight on) 10.183 miles.
- ➤ Continue on A465 to exit at next junction (signpost Seven Sisters), climbing to the Tonna roundabout, where take first exit to Aberdulais interchange where circle roundabout and take fourth exit down slip road to re-join the A465 eastward. 15.063 miles.
- Continue along A465 to Resolven roundabout to take second exit (straight on) 19.719 miles.
- Continue on A465 to Blaengwrach roundabout (McDonalds). 22.764 miles.
- ➤ Take second exit continuing on A465, passing over river bridge and the Glynneath interchange to remain on A465 to finish in the second layby on the left at a point 25 yards west of the 'take litter home' sign and opposite the emergency telephone point. 25.014 miles.

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There will be marshals stationed at key points throughout the course but please remember that their role is to help you steer the right course. Ultimately though, that's your responsibility as a rider and the marshals have no authority to control traffic. So please take the time to familiarise yourself with the course, particularly the turnaround point at 15.1 miles. To assist you in this, we've created a short video clip of this section of the route. Digital readers please click here. Please don't ruin a good ride by taking the wrong exit!

In addition, the name of the overall fastest rider will be recorded in the **Bryn Griffiths Memorial Book** and the fastest team will receive the **N&N Trophy** – both to be presented at the conclusion of the event.

A few points to note:

➤ Whilst technically they're split across two events, male riders will be regarded as a single "pool" for the purposes of these awards.

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- > Similarly, junior/juvenile riders are regarded as a single pool regardless of gender or event placement.
- ➤ The best improvers will be assessed against the LTS performances that appear on the start sheet, but only actual LTS performances are eligible sorry, but estimated PBs won't count. We'll make every effort to gather the very latest PB time for each rider from the CTT website, but will use the information on the start sheet as our definitive reference point.
- > The veteran awards are not gender-specific.
- ➤ We're not operating a one-rider-one-prize rule; so if you earn it, you get it.

DISTRICT RULES

All riders are asked to comply with the following.

- Please call your number to the finishing timekeeper otherwise your time may not be recorded.
- Please keep your head up, be aware of your surroundings and HAVE A SAFE RIDE.
- IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY Cycling Time Trials and the Event Promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted standard. In accordance with Regulation 15 ALL JUNIOR competitors must wear protective helmets. It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.
- This event may be subject to doping control. It is YOUR responsibility to check.
- Sign in AND sign out; failure to do so will result in a disqualification.
- Please don't pass the start time keeper or warm up on the course.
- ➤ Don't use a turbo trainer within 100m of residential areas or in Station Road opposite the start timekeeper (Thirteenth Avenue).
- No parking in Halt Road near the start. South Wales DC has already received complaints about riders parking across residents' driveways and can ill afford any more.
- The R25/3L has already been withdrawn because of nuisance complaints; regrettably, some riders still don't appreciate that we're guests in the Rhigos Village area.
- ➤ No anti-social behaviour especially urinating in public. It really shouldn't need mentioning, but unfortunately it does.
- Failure to follow these basic rules will result in a disqualification and referral to the South Wales DC for further disciplinary action.
- Please respect this information and accept these notices as a fair warning. We will have spotters patrolling the area to ensure compliance but we hope everyone will help us maintain the reputation of the sport we all enjoy.



HISTORY OF OUR EVENT

With just a couple of breaks in the sequence, the club has staged a 25-mile open almost every year since it was formed in 1927 and TT historians will recognise many of the names on our roll of honour.

Firstly, some facts and figures from our 2017 event:

- > 56 riders improved on their LTS performance
- ... by an average of 2m 36s
- ... for a combined improvement of 2h 25m 23s
- > 10 riders with times below 50:00
- > 115 riders within "the hour"
- ➤ Kieron Davies' winning time of 45m 37s was a new record for the Acme Wheelers event
- ... the record was previously held by Michael Hutchinson at 47m 00s [2011 event]
- ➤ With his 2017 win, Kieron Davies became the fifth rider to collect a hat-trick of wins a list that's topped by D. Rogers and J. Pritchard who each registered six victories.
