Conditions were dry and sunny, with a reasonable temperature. The weather station at Credenhill showed the wind was light and from the north (a sidewind on this course), though somewhat variable in direction. If this variability provided more benefit to certain parts of the field than to others, there's no real sign of it in the results. Compared to last year, which experienced an unhelpful tailwind from the left going out and a stiff headwind from the right coming back, times were quicker by between 30 seconds at the sharp end to as much as one minute in the mid-field.

Although there were more PB's this time, it was still a small proportion of the total field (most of whom I presume must be taking this distance pretty seriously); particular congratiulations to Will and to Michelle therefore.

Only 8 entrants DNS'd (six solos and one 2-up team) out of the 93 total, and there were no DNF's.
